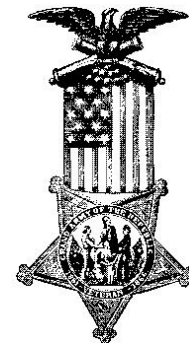




## SONS OF UNION VETERANS OF THE CIVIL WAR Department of Michigan

- 5:30pm Michigan Delegation Dinner at General Pickett's Buffet

Sunday Nov. 20, 2016

- 8:30am (Backup Plan to pick up flags at National Cemetery)
